Financial Aid Policy

Rush Wisconsin is committed to finding ways for players to participate in the sport of soccer, regardless of financial ability. As such, our club has set aside a limited amount of funds available for those families who are unable to meet their entire financial obligation to participate. These funds are administered by the Financial Aid Committee who is appointed by the Rush Wisconsin Board of Directors.

Financial Aid will be granted based on the following criteria: gross monthly income, family size, participation in the free and reduced lunch program, and other extenuating circumstances as defined by the applicant. The awards will depend upon the number of applicants and the amount of funds available on an annual basis. Each application will be considered on a case by case basis. The financial aid award can ONLY be applied toward the player program registration. The recipient's family will be required to cover the remaining portion of the program registration fee, try out fee, uniform fee, and any other team cost (including but not limited to: referee fees, travel costs, tournament fees and any other related team expenses.)

Application Process

1. Complete the Financial Aid application and Financial Agreement forms. Application is located on the Playmetrics website and app under Club Programs.
2. Provide the following documentation: two recent employment pay stubs detailing gross income OR proof of participation in a reduced fee school lunch program and any other information that might assist in determining your eligibility.
3. You must register online with a \$100.00 deposit
4. You will be notified via Playmetrics whether your application was approved or denied.

Application Deadlines

- Competitive League:
Aug. 1st, 2022 (HS Girls & 2013-2008 Teams) & Nov. 15th, 2022 (HS Boys)
- Youth/Recreational League: August 1st, 2022
- Players who join Rush after the start of the season will have 2 weeks to submit the application.
